

Post-doctoral fellowship of Indian Society of Nephrology-

It gives us great pleasure to invite you to announce the post-doctoral fellowship of the Indian Society of Nephrology

About Post-doctoral fellowship of Indian Society of Nephrology:

Background: During the training of DM(Nephrology) and DrNB (Nephrology), depending on the strengths of the training institute the student may not be proficient in some finer aspects of Nephrology. This fellowship is currently designed to fill this gap for some students.

Topics for fellowship:

1. Transplantation- 6 months
2. Intervention Nephrology- 6 months
3. Pediatric Nephrology- 6 months
4. Clinical Nephrology / Hemodialysis technology- 3 months
5. Critical care nephrology including POCUS -6 months

Eligibility & Value:

1. Students who have recently passed DM(Nephrology) OR DrNB (Nephrology) are eligible.
- 2 Should have passed the qualifying examination not more than 3 years previous to applying. Exception is made for candidates who are required to fulfill their government bond obligations. They can apply within 2 years after completing the bond.
- 3 The plan is to give one fellowship to one candidate.
4. Selection will depend on i) the self-selected goals, ii) acceptance by the host mentor, iii) recommendation by the home mentor, and iv) assignment of specific faculty to the candidate.
- 5 The mentor as well as the mentee will have to be members of the Indian Society of Nephrology.
- 7 After receiving the fellowship application, the fellowship committee will do the matching of the defined goal by candidate and expertise and willingness of the Centre to accept.
- 8 The candidate will be given a grant of INR 50,000 per month from Indian Society of Nephrology.
- 9 After fellowship the mentor will have to submit a log book and report of the candidate's evaluation of the training received. Also, a report regarding the candidate from the host mentor will be needed.
- 10 The candidate will receive a certificate from the Indian Society of Nephrology on successful completion of the fellowship.

11 The host institute should be willing to provide hands on work to the candidate. Host institute to please help find accommodation for the candidate so that attendance, as well as duties, can be smoothly done.

12 The candidate will be responsible for travel & and accommodation at the training city and pay any fee required by the institute to join the fellowship.
